 SEEKING THE SOUL was unhurried early on along the five path, shifted into the three path entering the lane, altered out near the three sixteenth pole and bothered multiple foes, rallied down the lane, edged past the leader, was under a long drive, came out a bit in the final sixteenth and held off rival in the final stages. GOOD SAMARITAN raced back early on from the four path, fanned into the eight path entering the lane, rallied in the stretch, made a bid three wide in the final sixteenth but could not get to the winner in the final stages. HOPPERTUNITY was reserved early on along the six path, went into the eight path entering the lane, rallied in the stretch, made a bid from between horses but was in tight and steadied while hanging in the final stages. DIVERSIFY set a clear pace from the four path early on while being tugged a bit in the backstretch, shifted into the three path in the far turn and faltered late in the stretch run. THE PLAYER chased the pace early along the seven path, went into the six path entering the lane, was bothered a bit near the three sixteenth pole and weakened late in the drive. DESTIN stalked the pace early from the three path, was a little off the rail into the lane and faded late in the stretch drive. GOATS TOWN tracked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn, was bothered slightly near the three sixteenth pole and was empty late in the drive. MO TOM raced along the six path early on, went into the seven path entering the lane making a slight bid, was bothered near the three sixteenth pole and tired late. HONORABLE DUTY raced up close early on, began to tire along the far turn, was pulled up in the stretch and walked off after the race. THE RIDER OF HOPPERTUNITY CLAIMED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDER OF SEEKING THE SOUL FOR INTERFERENCE LATE IN THE STRETCH RUN BUT AFTER REVIEW BY THE STEWARDS THE CLAIM WAS DISALLOWED.
