GOOD SAMARITAN raced back early on from the four path, fanned into the eight path entering the lane, rallied in the stretch, made a bid three wide in the final sixteenth but could not get to the winner in the final stages. HOPPERTUNITY was reserved early on along the six path, went into the eight path entering the lane, rallied in the stretch, made a bid from between horses but was in tight and steadied while hanging in the final stages. DIVERSIFY set a clear pace from the four path early on while being tugged a bit in the backstretch, shifted into the three path in the far turn and faltered late in the stretch run. THE PLAYER chased the pace early along the seven path, went into the six path entering the lane, was bothered a bit near the three sixteenth pole and weakened late in the drive. DESTIN stalked the pace early from the three path, was a little off the rail into the lane and faded late in the stretch drive. GOATS TOWN tracked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn, was bothered slightly near the three sixteenth pole and was empty late in the drive. MO TOM raced along the six path early on, went into the seven path entering the lane making a slight bid, was bothered near the three sixteenth pole and tired late. HONORABLE DUTY raced up close early on, began to tire along the far turn, was pulled up in the stretch and walked off after the race.
