GUN RUNNER set the pace early from the three path, angled off the rail entering the lane, was pressured nearing the eighth pole but repelled that bid and shook away in the final stages. BREAKING LUCKY stalked the pace early along the four path, stayed in the four path in the far turn, rallied into the lane, made a bold bid nearing the eighth pole but was no match for the winner in the final stages. SHAMAN GHOST was bumped a bit at the start and raced back early along the six path, shifted into the three path entering the lane and flattened out late in the stretch run. HOPPERTUNITY was unhurried early from the seven path, went into the six path entering the lane while making a bid but weakened late in the stretch drive. HAWAAKOM trailed the field early along the inside, steadied a bit once in the backstretch, swung into the six path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch. EFFINEX came out at the start, raced up close early from the five path, fanned into the eight path entering the lane and was empty in the stretch run. NOBLE BIRD was bothered a bit at the start but well placed early along the seven path, made a bid inside the five sixteenth pole, angled into the five path entering the lane and faded in the stretch. ARE YOU KIDDING ME was bumped and bothered at the start and eventually no threat. PRAYER FOR RELIEF chased the pace early from the six path, shifted into the four path in the far turn and was tired down the lane. MR. Z had early speed then folded up.
