APPROVAL close up stalking the pace outside a rival throughout, went on willingly outside the winner late to just miss. ARTISTE ROYAL (IRE) well placed tracking the winner along the inside to the stretch, came a bit off the rail in the lane and continued gamely between foes late. FANTASTIC SPAIN angled in leaving the hill and saved ground chasing the pace, remained inside in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. QUINQUIN THE KING (FR) steadied in tight inside in the run down the hill, came outside a rival to chase the pace to the stretch and lacked a further response. SHARP WRITER four wide on the hill and three deep into the stretch the first time, stalked outside a rival then off the rail on the backstretch, continued outside a foe leaving the second turn and weakened, then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off.
