PARADISE WOODS a step slow to begin, went between horses early then chased just off the rail, continued inside on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed response. SPRING IN THE WIND also a step slow into stride, stalked three deep then outside a rival, went three wide on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. QUEEN BEE TO YOU had speed three deep then dueled outside the winner, dropped back on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the drive.
