1 $\frac{3}{4}$  MILES. (Turf) (1.524) STAKES. Purse \$750,000 COLONIAL TURF CUP S.(GRADE III) OUTER TURF FOR THREE YEAR OLDS EARLY CLOSING MAY 21, 2007. Also includes being nominated to The Virginia Derby at a fee of \$750. LATE NOMINATIONS CLOSED MONDAY, JUNE 4, 2007,FOR A FEE OF \$1,000. \$2425 to pass the entry box. \$2425 additional to start with \$750,000 Guaranteed, of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Supplemental nominations of \$15,000. each will be accepted by the usual time of entry with all other fees due as noted. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of two races of \$75,000 at one mile or over since April 1, 2007, allowed 2 lbs.; of such a race since then, 4 lbs.; of a race of \$50,000 at a mile or over in 2007, 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Field will be limited to fourteen starters with preference to Graded/Group Stakes winners in order(I-II-III), Stakes winners, then highest career earnings. Six horses may be placed on the also-eligible list. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Early nominations closed Monday, May 21, with 78 nominations. Late nominations closed Monday, June 4, with 5 nominations. Trophy presented to the winning owner, trainer, and jockey. (Clear 81)

Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Mar), by Street Cry (IRE) - Dance for Dixie by Unaccounted For. Trainer Violette, Jr. A. Richard. Bred by Gentry Stable(KY).

SUMMER DOLDRUMS , forwardly placed towards the inside and under a rating hold, eased out some nearing the far turn, angled out six wide entering the lane and bumped with BRAINY BENNY (IRE), responded to right handed pressure, forged to a short lead leaving the sixteenth pole then dug in tenaciously under strong left handed urging to narrowly prevail. STRIKE A DEAL stalked the pace while saving ground, eased out for room in upper stretch, altered out again near mid stretch, lodged a bid between rivals a sixteenth out, battled gamely inside of the winner and just missed. SOUVENIR SLEW cleared early and angled towards the inside, set a moderate pace under pressure down the backstretch, shook clear again near the furlong marker then could not contain the top pair. MYSTERIOUS PEINTRE (FR) stalked the pace three wide, made a move to loom boldly nearing mid stretch then faded in the final sixteenth. LOVE DUBAI , unhurried early, came very wide for the drive and finished with good energy. SOLDIER'S DANCER lost ground three to four wide, steadily advanced leaving the three furlong marker, was bothered by STRIKE A DEAL near the furlong marker when that one came out then faded. BRAINY BENNY (IRE) , unhurried early, made a six wide run into the lane, bumped with the winner then failed to sustain his run. MINT SLEWLEP pressed the pace two wide and weakened in the drive. TIME SQUARED , forwardly placed off the rail, raced between rivals leaving the far turn then weakened in upper stretch.
