Purse \$600,000 *COLONIAL TURF CUP S.(GRADE III) OUTER TURF FOR THREE YEAR OLDS EARLY CLOSING MAY 28, 2008.* Also includes being nominated to The Virginia Derby at a fee of \$600. LATE NOMINATIONS CLOSED MONDAY, JUNE 9, FOR A FEE OF \$750. \$2425 to pass the entry box. \$2425 additional to start with \$600,000 Guaranteed, of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of two races of \$75,000 at one mile or over since April 1, 2008, allowed 2 lbs.; of such a race since then, 4 lbs.; of a race of \$50,000 at a mile or over in 2008, 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Early nominations closed Wednesday, May 28, 2008; late nominations closed Monday, June 9, 2008, for a total of 64 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighth). (Rainy 84)

SAILOR'S CAP stalked the pace under patient handling, advanced four wide entering the stretch, swept to command near the three sixteenths pole then eagerly pulled away while kept under encouragement. NISTLE'S CRUNCH , kept in the two path, stalked the pace, advanced outside KENTUCKY BEAR to gain the lead near the quarter pole, was no match for the winner but willingly held the place. YOUR ROUND lacked speed, raced wide entering the backstretch, advanced very wide into the stretch and continued well to rally for the show. COURT VISION lacked speed, raced inside horses on the far turn, eased out near the quarter pole, worked between horses in upper stretch and rallied. ADRIANO lost ground the first turn, advanced three wide, bid for the lead between horses entering the stretch and weakened the final furlong. BALTIMORE BOB raced forwardly inside horses, eased out in upper stretch and weakened. EL SULTRY SUN lacked speed, raced in the three path entering the stretch, angled to the rail in midstretch and failed to sustain his run. SPORTING ART , three wide the first turn, raced wide the far turn and failed to menace. BOSS LAFITTE , very wide the far turn, gave way. KENTUCKY BEAR , quickly clear, set the pace along the rail and gave way in upper stretch.
