A supplemental nomination fee of \$1,000 may be made at closing time of entries. \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. All starters will be required to pay entry and starting fees. The p urse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 other than restricted stake; or \$35,000 twice in 2010 allowed 2 lbs.; \$35,00 0 at a mile or over in 2010, 4 lbs.; \$35,000; or three races other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, March 27, 2010 with 27 Nominations. (Clear 57)

TOUCHING BEAUTY patiently stalked the leader while travelling in the three path, inched forward nearing the top of the stretch, responded positively when given her cue in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, forged to the front by the time she reached the eighth pole then dug in with determination under good handling to prevail. SPEIGHTFUL AFFAIR unhurried off the inside behind a host of rivals, swung outward entering the stretch, came home with good courage to garner place honors. C C'S PAL sat perched four wide within striking distance for three-quarters, displayed a good kick to grab the show. INDIAN BURN outrun for six furlongs, came four wide into the lane and had a good finish down the outside of the track. VOLARE CANTARE prompted the pacesetter from the outside, was slowly being passed by several rivals during the stretch drive, when forced to steady at the three-sixteenths pole to avoid a pair of troubled foes, settled back into stride until midstretch before steadily weakening thereafter. ANCHORAGE bumped lightly with SHE'LL BE DOGGONE twice leaving the starting gate, causing her to stumble the second time, cut the fractions under rating tactics while racing towards the inside, drifted out into the two path turning for home, came inward, despite left handed encouragement, shutting off SHE'LL BE DOGGONE, while bumping soundly with that rival and brushing into the fence as a result, had little to offer afterwards. SHE'LL BE DOGGONE patiently tracked the front runners from the pocket, was forced to be kept on hold while lacking clear sailing, found a narrow seam in upper stretch, was in the process of squeezing through, when shut off by ANCHORAGE, causing her to stumble after being bumped hard, then finished under her own power after having lost all chance. ROMAN CHESTNUT was never in contention. There was a Stewards' Inquiry into the incident during the stretch drive before the result was declared official.
