Bay Filly, (Apr), by Unbridled's Song - Lemons Forever by Lemon Drop Kid. Trainer Dallas Stewart. Bred by Charles Fipke (KY).

FOREVER UNBRIDLED three wide in range of the front, got set down three wide into upper stretch, rallied to get on near even terms a furlong from home, dug in dueling through the final eighth trading minor bumps and leans through to the wire and got up gamely in the final strides to prevail. CARRUMBA bobbed at the start, recovered to be forwardly placed just off the inside in close range of the leader, came under coaxing five-sixteenths out, seizing narrow command, swung just off the inside for home, dug in under threat and got hooked up head to head with the aforementioned foe a furlong out, fought gamely through to the finish trading minor bumps and leans and was denied to the line while well clear of the rest. WONDER GAL tracked the pace along the inside, came under urging five-sixteenths from home, angled four wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive while along for the show. STROKE PLAY three wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing four wide seven-sixteenths from home, spun five wide into upper stretch, passed tired foes for the last major share. PEACE AND WAR at the rear saving ground, came under urging seven-sixteenths from home, angled six wide into upper stretch, improved position through the stretch. FAST RETAILING three wide near the rear, came under urging three furlongs from home, spun four wide at the quarter pole, made no impact. TEMPER MINT PATTY coaxed from the gate, established the front from the two path before tucking to the inside into the first turn, showed the way in hand until put to coaxing three furlongs out, got headed five-sixteenths from home, cut the corner into upper stretch under a drive and faltered. JC'S SHOOTING STAR two to three wide in pursuit under prolonged urging from the seven-sixteenths, swung four wide for home, tired. PANGBURN saved ground in mid pack, came under encouragement three furlongs from home, swung three wide into upper stretch and tired. CURLISH FIGURE chased inside from near the rear, came under a ride seven-sixteenths from home, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and tired.
