Non-winners of a Grade I stakes since November 5, allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade I or II stakes since October 8, 4 lbs.; \$45,000 in 2011, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, April 6, 2011 with 17 nominations. AIKENITE angled out early and then back in near the half mile marker, steadied behind the leader when last soon after a quarter, recovered, moved to the outside for the drive and closed fast to be clear. COOL BULLET pressed the early pace while well out in the strip, angled in nearing the turn, battled for the advantage in the two path around the bend, drew clear once in the stretch but was no match for the winner late. LE GRAND CRU set the early pace off the rail, saved ground on the turn, stayed on well to the final furlong and weakened. WISE DAN moved out early when the winner angled out, moved up outside late on the backstretch to challenge, dropped back a bit on the turn then had no rally. TAQARUB forwardly placed off the inside, stopped.
