7 FURLONGS. (1.204) STAKES. Purse \$175,000 COMMONWEALTH S. (GRADE II) FOR FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$8,750 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$875 to enter and an additional \$875 to start, with \$175,000 guaranteed, of which \$105,000 to the owner of the winner, \$35,000 to second, \$17,500 to third, \$8,750 to fourth, \$5,250 to fifth and \$3,500 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I stakes since November 4, allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade I or II stakes since October 7, 5 lbs. The Commonwealth will be limited to fourteen starters. In the event that more than fourteen pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to nominees that have won a graded or group stakes (in order I-II-III), then highest earnings in 2011-2012. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, April 4, 2012 with 13 nominations. Chestnut Horse, (Feb), by Broken Vow - Street Cat by Storm Cat. Trainer Maker J. Michael. Bred by Jon Kelly & Sarah Kelly (KY). LONESOME STREET outrun for a half while unhurried, angled out soon after, made a bold five wide run into the stretch, challenged with a furlong to go and drew clear under steady urging. BERGERAC within striking distance, moved up three wide after a half, was carried out in upper stretch then held on for the place. RIGHT ONE (FR) outrun early off the inside, made a good run on his own after a half, gained a short lead once in the stretch but tired in the final furlong. EL GRAN SOL carried out in the chute, raced behind the leaders three wide, came four wide into the stretch and tired. PLUTONIUM carried out in the chute, alternated for the lead off the rail, drifted out in upper stretch and tired. COMEDERO drifted out early carrying several rivals out, vied for the lead inside and faded. PHILIPPE carried out in the chute, raced within striking distance inside and faded.
