7 FURLONGS. (1:21¹) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 Commonwealth S. (Grade III) FOR FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$7,500 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$1,250 to enter and an additional \$1,250 to start, with \$250,000 guaranteed, of which \$150,000 to the owner of the winner, \$50,000 to second, \$25,000 to third, \$12,500 to fourth, \$7,500 to fifth and \$5,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I stakes since November 3, allowed 3 lbs.; \$60,000 since September 1, 5 lbs. The Commonwealth will be limited to fourteen starters. In the event that more than fourteen pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest earnings in 2017-2018. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner. Closed Wednesday, March 21, 2018 with 30 nominations. (Cloudy 30)

WARRIOR'S CLUB stalked the pace early along the three path, in tight and blocked nearing the quarter pole, was in the three path entering the lane with room, made a bid while three across nearing the eighth pole, edged clear and held in the final stages. LIMOUSINE LIBERAL came in at the start and was pulled into the traffic along the backstretch from the four path, fanned into the five path entering the lane, made a bid four wide nearing the eighth pole, continued the bid from between horses late but did not have enough. AWESOME SATURDAY raced back early on along the six path, fanned into the seven path in the turn, made a bid five wide nearing the eighth pole, continued the bid three wide late but did not have enough. BEHAVIORAL BIAS was fractious in the gate prior to the start, chased the pace early while off the rail, was along the rail through the turn, angled back off the rail entering the lane, made a bold bid down the lane from the rail but hung in the late stages. WESTWOOD set the pace early while off the rail, shifted into the three path in the turn and yielded late in the stretch run. CONQUEST WINDYCITY pressed the pace early along the five path, shifted into the four path entering the lane and weakened late in the stretch drive. HEARTWOOD came in at the start and was slow early on, shifted into the four path in the turn and improved position down the lane. FIRST PREMIO was never a threat. CREWMAN stalked the pace early from the five path, swung into the six path in the turn and was empty late in the stretch.
