1 1/4 MILES. (Turf) (1.403) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 *COMMONWEALTH TURF S. (GRADE III) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS*. By subscription of \$100 each or by supplementary nomination of \$5,000 each at time of entry. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight, 123 lbs. Non winners of a graded or group stakes at a mile or over on the turf in 2008, 2 lbs.; a sweepstakes at a mile or over on the turf in 2008, 4 lbs.; two races other than claiming at a mile or over in 2008, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and start ing fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Wednesday, October 22, 2008 with 24 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One and One Sixteenth mile.). (Clear 44)

NISTLE'S CRUNCH was well placed along the hedge, shifted out to the two path entering the stretch, slipped to the inside with a furlong to run to make his bid, was blocked and steadied and altered course back to the outside, split horses and was up with a rush to prevail in the final yards. SEASPEAK was allowed to settle into stride, ranged up three wide to engage the leaders, drew even entering the stretch and battled determinedly but was denied late. JIMMY SIMMS pressed the pace two wide, forged a narrow lead nearing the five-sixteenths marker, continued on willingly through the drive but grudgingly gave way in the final yards. SNOOSE GOOSE settled into stride between horses, angled out entering the stretch, came four wide and was gaining steadily through the drive. VEILED PROPHET angled in to save ground early, closed the gap along the inside, worked his way off of the hedge entering the stretch and finished fairly well from between horses. AMAZING RESULTS settled under a snug hold in the back of the pack, made a mild bid circling five wide but failed to sustain the drive. CHEROKEE TRIANGLE set the pressured pace along the inside, was headed leaving the second turn, weakened and was caught in tight with a furlong to run, steadied and dropped out thereafter. ALLSAROTT was allowed to settle into stride, made a belated gain circling the field but was never a factor. MR MACCOOL contended between horses for six furlongs and faded. BOSS LAFITTE trailed.
