1 1/4 MILES. (Turf) (1.394) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 COMMONWEALTH TURF S. (GRADE III) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each or by supplementary nomination of \$5,000 each at time of entry. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight, 123 lbs. Non winners of a graded or group stakes at a mile or over on the turf in 2010, 2 lbs.; a sweepstakes at a mile or over on the turf in 2010, 4 lbs.; two races other than claiming at a mile or over in 2010, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Wednesday, October 27, 2010 with 39n omissions. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One and One Sixteenth mile.). (Clear 63)

YANKEE FORTUNE close up three wide, made a run at the leader on the second turn, drew clear into the stretch and maintained a safe lead while kept to the task. GUYS REWARD reserved while within reach of the lead, angled out four wide late on the second turn when rallying and finished willingly to be gaining late. TURALLURE unhurried three wide, angled out a bit and made a good four wide run to the three furlong marker, tracked the leaders into midstretch but lodged only a mild late bid. MYSTIC outrun three wide, made a good middle move in that path but lodged only a mild late bid. MISTER MARTI GRAS unhurried off the rail, steadied behind rivals approaching the stretch when five wide, came to the outside once in the stretch and made a late gain. STORMY LORD pressed the early pace off the inside, took over before a half, held for six furlongs, held on well to midstretch and tired. CELTIC NEW YEAR close up early along the inside, lacked a closing bid. DON CAVALLO within striking distance three wide, weakened in the stretch. THUNDER BREW outrun while in hand, moved five wide with three furlongs to go and could not menace. DARK COVE reserved off the inside, raced three wide once on the second turn and could not menace. BEAU CHOIX in hand four wide, was no threat. UAREOUTLAW (BRZ) had speed for a half. LIGHTHOUSE SOUND vied for the lead inside and stopped.
