LEA rated while close up and three wide, challenged when ready midway through the second turn, drew clear into the stretch when asked and lasted late. KING DAVID unhurried off the inside, worked his way forward after five furlongs, raced in traffic entering the stretch, was blocked once in the stretch, angled out and closed well late. LOCKOUT outrun early three wide, commence his rally four wide with three furlongs to go, bumped with FINNEGANS WAKE midway through the second turn, advanced four wide into the stretch, made a good run to the final furlong but lodged only a mild late bid. SKYRING reserved four wide, moved up in that path after three furlongs, reached a forward position midway through the second turn but lacked a late bid. ANY GIVEN ROYAL reserved off the rail, steadied behind a tiring CASUAL TRICK midway through the second turn, angled out entering the stretch and showed late interest. ARTEST unhurried three wide, maintained his position to the stretch and improved that position late. FINNEGANS WAKE outrun off the rail, bumped with LOCKOUT midway through the second turn, was in close when the runner up angled out in upper stretch then made a belated bid. EXCAPER within striking distance four wide, moved to a challenging position three wide on the second turn but tired in the drive. QUICK WIT forwardly placed three wide, held on well to the stretch and tired. FINALE alternated for the lead off the inside, stayed on to the final quarter and faded. FILM SHOT close up while in hand along the inside, moved off the rail for the second turn, held on to the final furlong and gave way. TWO MONTHS RENT within reach off the inside, faded in the stretch. BURN THE MORTGAGE outrun three wide, moved out to the five path on the second turn and could not menace. CASUAL TRICK forced the pace along the inside and stopped.
