CONSORTIUM was lightly handed to take up a forward position, underwent a three wide pursuit, ranged up, still without being asked for serious run nearing the quarter pole, turned for home having secured a good striking position, closed in on the front runner, spurted away when finally released from the good grip on the reins in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, was kept to steady hand encouragement before being geared down in the late stages. RISE AGAINST angled three wide into the stretch and rallied for the place. SCHOOL SPIRIT lightly bumped at the start, tracked the leader from the inside, got out finished. LOVE TO RUN made light contact with an errant IMPERIAL CROWN leaving the starting gate, disputed the pace from the two path and backed away. MARKET STRIKE three wide on the turn, displayed a mild stretch response to improve position. COMMON BOND saved ground on the turn, lacked the necessary stretch response. TRUSTED CHOICE was no factor. FILM SHOT broke outward a bit at the start, left the backstretch four wide, tired. D' PEPJO made light contact with CITY STRUT out of the starting gate, went on to take up a forward position, argued for command from the inside for a half, faltered despite being asked for run. WINDSURFER between rivals from the two path, tired. IMPERIAL CROWN stumbled at the start, was pulled off LOVE TO RUN but not before making slight contact, took the inside route and was outrun. RAPACIOUS urged on the turn while giving chase, tired.
