1 $\frac{1}{2}$ MILES. (Turf) (1.40⁴) STAKES. Purse \$75,000 NEW YORK STALLION CORMORANT S. FOR COLTS AND GELDINGS THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD ELIGIBLE TO THE NEW YORK STALLION STAKES. Colts and Geldings that have been fully subscribed to The New York Stallion Series (all eligibility requirements met by their three year old season) are eligible to this race. \$350 to pass the entry box, \$400 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Three year olds, 122 lbs.; older 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$35,000 on the turf in 2007 allowed 2 lbs.; \$35,000 on the turf in 2006 or \$30,000 twice in 2007, 4 lbs.; \$30,000 in 2006 or four races lifetime, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the Main Track.). (Clear 44)

PA PA DA was outrun early, raced three wide on both turns and finished gamely outside. THECONFIDENCEMAN raced close up while in hand and was outfinished while between rivals in the stretch. HAMMOCK argued the pace from the outside and weakened in the stretch. OEDIPUS O'NEAL raced in hand while between rivals and had no response when roused. GET SERIOUS set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. HIGHLY SPOKEN was outrun early, came wide for the drive and had no rally. GOOD PROSPECT raced inside and tired. JELLY ROLL RUMBLE was outrun early and had no response when roused.
