1 $\frac{1}{4}$ MILES. (1.40⁴) STAKES. Purse \$750,000 **FITZ DIXON COTILLION S. (GRADE II) FOR FILLIES THREE YEAR OLDS.** By subscription of \$750 each which should accompany the nomination, \$1,500 to pass the entry box, \$2,000 additional to start, with \$750,000 guaranteed. The purse to be distributed: \$7,500 to all starters with the balance of the purse to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Winners of a grade I race at a mile or over in 2008 to carry 2 lbs. additional. Non-winners of a graded race at a mile or over in 2008 allowed 3 lbs. of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2008, 5 lbs.; of three races at a mile or over other than maiden or claiming in 2008, 8 lbs. This race will not be divided. A field of 14 horses will be drawn with the preference given to Graded/Group stakes winners in order (I-II-III), stakes winners, then highest career earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing on Tuesday, September 16, 2008. Nominations closed Saturday, September 6, 2008 with 21. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. (Clear 73)

SEATTLE SMOOTH was reserved inside early when in a bit tight, bid to contention after half a mile, angled out rallying into the stretch, collared the pacesetter and drew away. PROUD SPELL pursued the pace between foes, angled wide finding room into the lane, was bumped from the inside and rallied while no threat to the winner. COLOR ME UP set a slow pace under good rating, led to near midstretch, battled gamely when challenged by the winner then yielded. BY THE LIGHT pursued the pacesetter outside, bumped with Proud Spell while weakening at the top of the lane and faltered. PICKER raced off the pace while four wide and began retreating on the final turn. MILLION DOLLAR RUN broke a step slowly, moved very wide on the first turn, angled inside but was no factor.
