BOOK REVIEW bumped with SAY A NOVENA several strides after the start, was unhurried while racing in the two path around the first

turn, angled out near the half-mile pole, edged closer down the backstretch, moved five wide nearing the quarter pole, quickly gained four and

five wide around the far turn, struck the front in upper stretch and drew clear under brisk hand urging. HOLIDAY SOIREE pressed the pace two

wide between rivals around the first turn, rated back into a stalking position nearing the half-mile pole, re-bid two wide around the far turn, reached even terms nearing the lane, appeared to flatten out while continuing on her left lead in upper stretch, switched leads leaving the

sixteenth pole and finished willingly to gain the place. BEAUTIFUL BUT BLUE broke a bit slowly, rushed up to press the pace three wide around the first turn, pressed two wide down the backstretch, took the lead near the five-sixteenths pole, cleared and angled in near the quarter pole, led to upper stretch, drifted out leaving the eighth pole, drifted back in near the sixteenth marker and held well enough to preserve the show. AMIE'S DINI lacked speed while racing three wide, advanced four wide around the far turn to loom boldly nearing the lane, drifted in in upper stretch and flattened out a bit. SAY A NOVENA bumped with BOOK REVIEW several strides after the start, settled off the pace along the inside, moved two wide between foes down the backstretch, gave close chase two wide between foes around the far turn and weakened in

the drive. JAZZY IDEA tracked the pace three and four wide and lacked the needed rally. WELL KEPT settled just of the pace while racing two wide around the first turn, went three wide between foes around the far turn and lacked a rally. DEFY GRAVITY chased the pace inside and tired around the far turn. SWIFT ARTIST set a pressured pace along the rail, was collared near the five-sixteenths pole and retreated inside.
