IMPERATIVE settled off the pace in the three and four paths, bid nearing the three eighths pole, improved six wide on the far turn and dug in under determined stretch handling to get up the final strides. MATT KING COAL steadied from between horses into the first turn then stalked the pace three wide, was jostled nearing the five eighths pole, moved to even terms past the seven sixteenths, dueled to the front midway on the far turn, drifted into the lane, raced briefly clear inside the eighth pole but picked up the winner in deep stretch and grudgingly ceded to that one the final strides. WAR STORY, off the pace four wide, settled toward the outside into the backstretch, bid toward the three eighths pole, raced five wide in the far turn and dug in gamely through the lane. BODHISATTVA dropped well back from the early leaders to save ground, eased out into the backstretch, started a bid past the seven sixteenths pole, rounded the far turn about the six path and finished evenly to pass tiring rivals. STANFORD rated with the pace inside through most of the front stretch, eased to the two path to stalk the pace from the three quarter pole, moved to even terms into the backstretch, took the lead toward the seven sixteenths, was pressured for more at the three eighths, met at even terms midway on the far turn, dropped back into the stretch and weakened the final sixteenth. SUNNY RIDGE, off the pace inside, eased out into the backstretch, bid nearing the three eighths pole, rounded the far turn off the rail, drifted into the lane and showed little further. GANGSTER saved ground well off the pace, bid leaving the three eighths pole then flattened stride about the three path of the far turn. CAUTIOUS GIANT raced with the pace two deep the opening turn and rated a slim lead off the rail, was met a even terms leaving the half mile pole, briefly engaged in close chase from that point but faded approaching the final turn.
