1 1/4 MILES. (1.463) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 *CURLIN S. FOR THREE YEAR OLDS WHICH HAVE NOT WON A GRADED SWEEPSTAKES OVER A MILE IN 2012.* No nomination fee. \$1,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$500 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to entry. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$750 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstake at a mile or over in 2012 allowed 2 lbs., \$40,000 at a mile or over in 2011-12, 4 lbs.; a race at a mile or over, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered in allowances). A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Friday, July 20, 2012 with 34 Nominations. (Cloudy 78)

STREET LIFE came away in good order, settled at the back of the pack, well reserved in the two path, picked up interest nearing the end of the backstretch, was roused while angling to be outside all front runners midway on the far turn, gradually closed the gap approaching the quarter pole, was floated six wide into the stretch, the widest of a foursome, rubbing shoulders with EVER SO LUCKY while doing so, drifted back inward a couple of paths soon afterwards, ground his way to the front during the run through the furlong grounds, left the sixteenth pole a full length on top, continued to edge away from the competition, kept to a drive until the a few strides before reaching the finish line. FIVE SIXTEEN was strung out in the three path for most of the way around the clubhouse turn, continued along from off the inside but a bit closer to the rail until the quarter pole, stayed within range on the far turn while put to some urging, saw the front four swinging ever so wide into the stretch and was deftly maneuvered towards the rail, cut the corner into the lane under strong handling and grabbed a narrow advantage, yielded to the winner just before reaching the eighth pole, finished with good determination to preserve the place. EVER SO LUCKY nibbled against the bit proceeding down the homestretch but otherwise proved ratable, left the rail as he left the opening bend, departed the backstretch from the three path, and ranged up to reach a good striking position, spun five wide into the stretch, under urging, brushed with the winner while turning for home, fell back gradually during the stretch run and had to settle for the show. EASTER GIFT was under a firm hold from the rider disputing the pace two to three wide, remained a prominent factor for over three-quarters, came from the four path and from between rivals into the stretch, but had little left. RELOAD tucked along the rail entering the backstretch, flip flopping lanes with EVER SO LUCKY while doing so, saved ground until the quarter pole, was angled out at that station, came up empty and finished under a protective hold. LOVE TO RUN made a three wide to grab the lead, argued for command from the two path, lightly coaxed while doing so, drifted outward turning for home as the pressure intensified, taking three others for a short ride, continued to move in the direction of the grandstand apron while retreating and likewise crossed the finish line under a protective hold.
