1 1/2 MILE. (1:502) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 Curlin S.FOR THREE YEAR OLDS WHICH HAVE NOT WON A GRADED SWEEPSTAKES OVER A MILE IN 2015. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstake at a mile or over in 2015 allowed 2 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance races at a mile or over in 2015 allowed 4 lbs.; of such a race in 2015 allowed 6 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 18, 2015 with 25 Original Nominations and 2 Supplements. (Clear 81)

SMART TRANSITION crossed to the inside into the first turn and settled two to three wide just in behind the top trio knocking heads in hand on the front, remained patiently handled until nearing the five-sixteenths as **KING OF NEW YORK** ranged up outside, got put to urging at that juncture, angled four wide for home, dug in under a near sided stick shying slightly outwards before straightening away and taking over nearing the eighth pole, edged clear under a drive to prevail. **TEKTON** three wide through the first turn, vied three wide outside a pair while under a firm hold through moderate splits, shook off the innermost of the trio in tandem with **STANFORD** half a mile from home and knocked heads with that foe through the far turn coming under a drive swinging three wide into upper stretch, seized brief command three-sixteenths out before being overhauled by the top one near the eighth pole, ran on safe for the place. **KING OF NEW YORK** two to three wide near the rear, came under coaxing midway on the turn advancing into striking range swinging five wide for home, couldn't match strides with the top two while improving by weakening foes for the show honors. **BATTLE MIDWAY** away well, vied inside a pair while in hand until shaken off half a mile from home, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths remaining, cut the corner into upper stretch under a drive and weakened in the stretch. **STANFORD** vied in hand between foes in the two path, shook off **BATTLE MIDWAY** in tandem with **TEKTON** half a mile out and knocked heads through the turn coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home under threat to the outside, got headed by his main pace foe **TEKTON** three-sixteenths from home and faltered in the final eighth. **UNRIVALED** hesitated at the start breaking inwards sluggishly and conceding six to seven lengths to the front, raced three wide through the first turn, then three to four wide throughout, got spirited up with three furlongs to go and trailed throughout.
