BELIEVE IN BERTIE tugged at the bit under restraint, raced in the three to four path on the first turn, set the pace in hand while into the bit, controlled the action in the two path on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, responded well when set down in upper stretch, was put to a right-handed whip coming to the sixteenth-pole and held well under good handling in course record time. KITTEN'S ROAR went three then two wide on the first turn, settled in third position, raced two then three wide on the far turn, spun four wide into the stretch, was asked inside the three-sixteenths, chased under a strong hand ride, was put to the whip outside the furlong marker and finished with good courage to just get the place. CAMBODIA came away in front, showed no urgency to set the pace, allowed BELIEVE IN BERTIE to go to the front, raced in the two path on the first turn, tracked the pace in hand, rounded the far turn in the two path, was asked while tipping into the three path entering the stretch, drifted out a touch outside the three-sixteenths, chased into the final furlong, was put to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and also finished with good courage but just missed the place. PRADO'S SWEET RIDE went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along in the two path on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and failed to threaten. PRINCESS ERINDELLE raced in the two path early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, settled at the back, was urged along against the rail while inside of PRADO'S SWEET RIDE on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and was no factor.
