1 1/4 MILES. (Turf) (1.45²) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 DALLAS TURF CUP H. (GRADE III) (PLUS UP TO \$15,750 Open ATB) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$1,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start with \$200,000 guaranteed of which \$120,000 to the owner of the winner, \$40,000 to second, \$22,000 to third, \$12,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. Weights: Saturday, May 16, 2009. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred. The field will be limited to twelve starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Thursday, May 14, 2009 with 28 nominations. (If Deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighth.). (Clear 82)

SEASPEAK moved out early, stalked the pace on the outside, took the lead passing the half-mile pole, responded well to one crack of a left-handed whip in upper stretch and drew off then was eased up late. ERNESTO was reserved off the pace, moved up leaving the backstretch, made a mild bid at the top of the stretch but proved no match for the winner while able to hold the place. RED ROCK CREEK was reserved near the back of the field, bumped with a rival while three wide on the far turn, moved in entering the stretch and came up empty while best of the rest. OVERBID raced three wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, bumped with rivals while four wide on the far turn, was in tight at the top of the stretch and also came up empty. PRECIOUS COLONY was taken up before passing the wire the first time and was a bit rank, shifted four wide late on the first turn, moved up on the outside, bumped with a rival while five wide on the far turn and had nothing left. TRICKY CAUSEWAY set the pace through sluggish fractions, relinquished the lead passing the half-mile pole, chased inside on the far turn, was in tight at the top of the stretch and gave way. (Rail at 0 Feet)
