POLITICALLYCORRECT chased a bit off the rail then outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up late. PRIVATE ZONE pulled his way along and dueled outside a rival, fought back on the turn, inched away in midstretch, drifted in then out a bit in deep stretch and was overtaken nearing the wire. BROTHER FRANCIS saved ground chasing the pace, moved up some on the turn, came off the rail in midstretch, split horses a sixteenth out and got up between foes for the show while in a bit tight off heels at the wire. SIR BOND chased off the rail then a bit off the fence on the turn, came out some in the stretch, was between rivals in deep stretch and lacked the needed rally. MILE HIGH MAGIC had speed off the inside then angled to the rail and dueled for the lead, briefly put a head in front nearing the turn, battled along the inside on the bend and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. OUR LUCKY SON allowed to settle off the rail, angled in a bit off the inside on the turn and lacked a response in the stretch.
