SANTA MONICA (GB) was two-wide on the opening turn, settled racing near the back, remained unhurried on the backstretch and far turn where she continued to race two-wide, angled out into the five-path turning for home, launched a rally, drifted inwards, reached the lead at the 1/16th pole and prevailed. INFLEXIBILITY was three-wide on the clubhouse turn, stalked the leader early, cleared to the lead past the 15/16ths pole, saved ground while leading the way on the far turn, was headed 1/16th out and was outkicked late. HOLY HELENA bumped into STARSHIP JUBILEE at the start, saved ground on the opening turn, settled near the back, advanced into contention turninfor home, launched a bid past the 1/4 pole when a clear path opened up and chased gamely despite being no match for the top two. BLETCHLEY (GB) quickly angled to the rail, trailed the field, saved ground on the far turn, gained some ground in early stretch, angled off of the rail at the 1/8th pole and chased gamely. LIBERTY KITTEN raced two-wide in midpack on the opening turn, took back past the 7/8ths pole, raced on the far outside, was three-wide on the far turn, hustled past the 3/8ths pole, was four-wide in upper stretch and chased in vain. STARSHIP JUBILEE was bumped by HOLY HELENA at the start, showed speed racing two-wide on the opening turn, was overtaken by INFLEXIBILITY and stalked the foe down the backstretch. saved ground on the far turn and flattened out in the stretch. MYTHICAL MISSION bumped with SABA at the start, was two-wide on the clubhouse turn, stalked while racing on the far outside down the backstretch, was three-wide on the far turn, was in range in early stretch but weakened past the 3/16ths pole. SABA (FR) bumped with MYTHICAL MISSION at the start, saved ground, checked hard entering the backstretch, raced in midpack, raced two and three-wide on the far turn, was blocked to the 1/4 pole and offered no rally. DREAM DANCING showed early speed, tracked the pacesetter, stalked while racing two-wide between foes on the far turn and faltered in the stretch.
