GOURMET DINNER was settled in the early going while racing three wide on the backstretch, rallied three wide on the far turn then was in a long drive, gained command in upper stretch then drew off in late stretch. DECISIVE MOMENT stalked the early pace while racing two wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn and was in a strong drive, dug in gamely in the stretch but was second best in the end. CLUBHOUSE RIDE was unhurried early then started a run heading into the far turn, made a quick move while two wide from between rivals then angled inside in upper stretch, was gaining ground in late stretch but was too late. SWEET DUCKY was well placed while racing three wide on the backstretch, rallied heading into the far turn but came up empty in the stretch drive. CLASSIC LEGACY was unhurried early while racing two wide on the backstretch, rallied two wide on the far turn but was no menace in the stretch drive. BUG JUICE set the early pace while being well handled, was used up on the far turn and weakened in the stretch drive. RUSH NOW was in tight heading into the first turn then stalked the early pace while racing between rivals on the backstretch, failed to respond when asked heading into the far turn. DREAMSRUNWILD was unhurried early and racing three wide down the backstretch, was carried out by the riderless horse to the outside fence then taken up sharply to avoid running over the fence causing the rider to lose his irons. BLUE LASER was unhurried early then raced three wide heading into the far turn, was carried out by then riderless horse to the outside fence and was pulled up and walked off. ACES N KINGS was inside in the early going and saved ground, was steadied slightly heading into the far turn then suddenly bolted to the outside in the middle of the far turn losing his rider and causing interference to trailing horses. A stewards inquiry was held concerning the incident on the far turn. After reviewing the films, no action was taken.
