BOUQUET BOOTH was settled in the early going then started a run on the backstretch, rallied three wide on the far turn then swung out in upper stretch to be four wide, was in a strong drive on the outside and was along in time. NIJI'S GRAND GIRL was allowed to settle while racing two wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn while three wide then made a strong bid, put a head in front in mid stretch but was outfinished in late stretch. GRANDACIOUS set the early pace while being well handled, drew off on the far turn then was all out in upper stretch but tired in late stretch. PROMISE ME A CAT stalked the early pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn to upper stretch then flattened out in the stretch drive. ALL ABOUT ALLIE was four wide on the run down the backstretch but failed to menace in the stretch drive. LITTLE WIDOW MAKER was outrun in the early going and kept to the inside, stayed inside for the stretch and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. PERFECTLY CANDID stalked the early pace while inside, saved ground on the far turn but faltered in the drive. PATTY'S PRIDE was unhurried early and was no factor. FISCAL POLICY chased the early pace while two wide, was hard used on the backstretch then gave way on the far turn.
