ACTION ANDY broke sharply, eased back four wide to track a contested pace, came under urging mid turn, angled out five wide entering the stretch, closed relentlessly under right handed pressure, drew alongside **IL VILLANO** in deep stretch and forged ahead by the slimmest of margins at the wire. **IL VILLANO** rated inside off the dueling leaders, angled four wide under pressure approaching the lane, rallied under left handed urging to take command with a sixteenth remaining, drifted out a bit late, battled gamely and nearly fended off the winner's charge. **IMMORTAL EYES** stumbled at the break, recovered to settle well off the pace, commenced a run four wide past the three eighths pole, swung seven wide into the stretch and finished with good energy. **ALSVID** was sent up five wide to join the fray, dueled three deep under some rating, held a short advantage past the furlong marker, was headed a sixteenth out and gave way grudgingly. **BROAD RULE** saved ground leaving the three eighths pole, angled out for the drive but lacked the needed response. **BET THE POWER** quickly reached contention along the rail, dueled on a slim lead around the turn, fought gamely inside **ALSVID** past the furlong grounds then weakened late. **SLOANE RANGER** saved ground, angled out leaving the eighth pole and had a mild late response. **SEAN AVERY**, fractious in the gate, gave chase four wide, angled six wide racing between foes into the stretch then faded. **ROYAL CURRIER**, urged along three wide trying to keep pace, retreated mid turn. **THE HUNK** was sent up between rivals early, dueled through brisk fractions to upper stretch then surrendered near the eighth pole. **PACIFIC OCEAN** gave brief chase and faltered.
