ACTION ANDY broke sharply, eased back four wide to track a contested pace, came under urging mid turn, angled out five wide entering the stretch, closed relentlessly under right handed pressure, drew alongside IL VILLANO in deep stretch and forged ahead by the slimmest of margins at the wire. IL VILLANO rated inside off the dueling leaders, angled four wide under pressure approaching the lane, rallied under left handed urging to take command with a sixteenth remaining, drifted out a bit late, battled gamely and nearly fended off the winner's charge. IMMORTAL EYES stumbled at the break, recovered to settle well off the pace, commenced a run four wide past the three eighths pole, swung seven wide into the stretch and finished with good energy. ALSVID was sent up five wide to join the fray, dueled three deep under some rating, held a short advantage past the furlong marker, was headed a sixteenth out and gave way grudgingly. BROAD RULE saved ground leaving the three eighths pole, angled out for the drive but lacked the needed response. BET THE POWER quickly reached contention along the rail, dueled on a slim lead around the turn, fought gamely inside ALSVID past the furlong grounds then weakened late. SLOANE RANGER saved ground, angled out leaving the eighth pole and had a mild late response. SEAN AVERY, fractious in the gate, gave chase four wide, angled six wide racing between foes into the stretch then faded. ROYAL CURRIER, urged along three wide trying to keep pace, retreated mid turn.
