1 MILE. (Inner Turf) (1:34) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 Fasig-Tipton De La Rose SINNER TURF FOR FILLIES AND MARES FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD WHICH HAVE NOT WON A GRADED SWEEPSTAKE IN 2015. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers.123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake at a mile or over in 2014 allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstake in 2014-15 at a mile or over allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance races at a mile or over in 2015 allowed 6 lbs.; of such a race in 2015 allowed 8 lbs. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Saturday July 25, 2015 with 36 Nominations. Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Feb), by Speightstown - Honor Bestowed by Honor Grades. Trainer James J. Toner. Bred by John W. Phillips & Hank Snowden (KY).

RECEPTA was reserved on the inside, continued to save ground while patiently ridden on the far turn, was asked while shifting three wide into the stretch, espied an opening between horses, burst through between those foes to make a bold bid at the three-sixteenths, came in closer to TUTTIPAESI while battling with that rival into the final furlong, shifted in a touch nearing the sixteenth-pole but was quickly corrected by the rider then drew clear under a strong hand ride. TUTTIPAESI (IRE) tugged at the bit while reserved near the rail on the first turn, raced in the back half of the field while under restraint, continued under restraint while towards the inside on the far turn, was asked turning into the stretch, accelerated quickly to make a bid near the rail at the three-sixteenths, battled with the winner into the final furlong, checked when that rival came in a touch nearing the sixteenth-pole in a bit of an overreaction by the rider then finished with good courage to hold the place. A LITTLE BIT SASSY bumped lightly with a rival at the start, went three wide on the first turn, was reserved in the back half of the field, raced in the two path early on the far turn, moved to the four path while getting closer outside the quarter-pole, swung six wide into the stretch, was set down in earnest while on the outside and finished willingly to just miss the place. TICKING KATIE (IRE) was eased back nearing the first turn, raced a bit off the rail on that bend, settled on the backstretch while under some restraint, went around the far turn in the two path, swung four wide into the stretch, moved out while put to a drive and lacked the needed kick. NELLIE CASHMAN raced in the two path on the first turn, settled on the outside, was asked while three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch, moved out under a drive and lacked the needed response. PINK POPPY raced in the two path on the first turn, was rated on the outside while forwardly placed, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, chased into upper stretch, made an outside bid while under a right-handed whip at the three-sixteenths, battled into the final furlong then weakened. TOKEN OF LOVE (GB) was taken back early, raced inside on the first turn, was reserved at the back under a tight hold, came under urging while along the rail on the far turn, cut the corner into the stretch and failed to rally. MISS FROST broke out and hit the gate then was corrected by the rider, went to the front, set the pace on the inside, was challenged near the five-sixteenths, turned into the stretch under the whip, lost the advantage while under a drive and gave way. DARING KATHY tracked the leader in the two path, made a bid at the five-sixteenths pole, floated four wide into the stretch, battled between horses past the three-sixteenths and came up empty. JOINT RETURN bumped lightly with a rival at the start, lagged at the back while towards the inside, was urged along on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch while under the whip and failed to threaten. Following the race, the rider of TUTTIPAESI claimed foul against RECEPTA for alleged interference near the sixteenth-pole. After the stewards' review, there was no change made to the order of finish. (Rail at 9 Feet)
