1 MILE. (Inner Turf) (1:33¹) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 Fasig-Tipton De La Rose S.INNER TURF FOR FILLIES AND MARES FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD WHICH HAVE NOT WON A GRADED SWEEPSTAKE IN 2016. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers.123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake on the turf in 2015 allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstake in 2015-16 allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance races 2016 allowed 6 lbs.; of such a race in 2016 allowed 8 lbs. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 23, 2016 with 30 Nominations. Bay Mare, (Jan), by Excellent Art (GB) - Shanty (GB) by Selkirk. Trainer William I. Mott. Bred by Shanty Syndicate (IRE).

LADY LARA (IRE) was taken in hand early then hard held along the hedge through the first turn, raced just behind the leader under restraint, drafted inside on the far turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, accelerated while cutting the corner into the stretch, stormed to the front at the three-sixteenths, shook clear into the final furlong and held under strong urging. STORMY VICTORIA (FR) saved ground on the first turn, tossed her head passing the three-quarter pole, settled off the pace, moved a bit closer late on the backstretch, raced inside on the far turn, advanced along the hedge into upper stretch, followed the winner through the inside at the three-sixteenths, tipped off the inside near the furlong marker and secured the place while unable to reach the winner. ZINDAYA went three wide on the first turn, settled in second flight on the outside, tucked into the two path early on the far turn, moved to the three path outside the quarter-pole, was asked at the top of the stretch, chased under a drive into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick while just able to get the show. ROCA ROJO (IRE) settled between horses in the two path under some restraint, was asked while still between horses in the two path on the far turn, raced under some urging while behind several horses in upper stretch, moved out in the vicinity of the furlong marker and finished willingly for the last spot in the superfecta in a bit of an uncomfortable trip. MY SWEET GIRL was keen in the early going, raced in the two path on the first turn, was reserved near the back of the field, saved ground on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, followed STORMY VICTORIA through on the inside at the furlong marker and also finished willingly but just missed the superfecta. ROBILLARD went three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, vied in the two path on the far turn, bumped with MAYLA in upper stretch and weakened. EXCILLY (GB) was taken in hand early, went three wide on the first turn then was reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn, was roused at the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, held a reasonable striking range past the eighth-pole, had the saddle slip forward in the final furlong which caused the jockey to lose control and lost any chance at the minor awards. BITTY KITTY moved in at the rear of the field, saved ground on the first turn, was unhurried at the back, went around the far turn in the two path, was roused while swinging four wide into the stretch, angled out under a drive and failed to rally. MAYLA set the pace on the inside through tepid fractions, was asked near the quarter-pole, lost the advantage near the three-sixteenths, bumped with ROBILLARD at that point and gave way.
