VAGABOND SHOES (IRE) settled outside a rival, came out leaving the last turn and four wide into the stretch, bid outside under urging in midstretch, gained the lead in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. LUCAYAN (FR) saved ground chasing the pace, waited off heels leaving the final turn, came out for room into the stretch, split rivals with a bid in midstretch and continued willingly toward the inside. HUNTSVILLE chased a bit off the rail or outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, gained a slim lead, fought back between foes in the final furlong and went gamely to the end. OLD TIME HOCKEY saved ground stalking the pace, awaited room leaving the last turn, came out into the stretch, bid between horses past the eighth pole and was outfinished. FIRE WITH FIRE stalked early then pressed the pace outside a rival, fought back between horses in the stretch and weakened late. MR T BIRD had speed inside and set a pressured pace along the rail, came off the fence some in the stretch and weakened in the final furlong.
