By subscription of \$400 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$3,000 additional to start, with \$400,000 Guaranteed, of which \$240,000 to first, \$80,000 to second, \$48,000 to third, \$24,000 to fourth and \$8,000 to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. First preference will be given to the winner(s) of the Oceanside Stakes. Second preference will be given to graded or group stakes winners. Third preference will be given to horses which have finished second or third in graded or group stakes. Total non-claiming purse earnings will determine the order of preference for horses of equal status. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. GET FUNKY pulled a bit early, dueled outside a rival then between foes into and on the second turn, inched away in midstretch and held on gamely under some urging. OBRIGADO (FR) a bit slow to begin, settled outside a rival, came out leaving the backstretch, went three deep leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied for the place. UNION AVENUE angled in and chased inside then a bit off the rail, went between foes into and on the second turn, waited a bit leaving that turn, continued between horses in midstretch and bested the others. PORTO SANTO (FR) chased outside a rival then three deep leaving the backstretch, continued off the rail on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LIGHTNING HIT (IRE) angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, split rivals past midstretch and could not summon the necessary response. NONSENSICAL stalked the pace off the rail, bid three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch, then weakened. PRESIDENTIAL CAUSE saved ground off the pace, went outside a rival on the second turn, angled out into the stretch and was not a threat. RATEAU had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the second turn but weakened in the final furlong. POINT DETERMINED wide in the chute, angled in and chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, dropped back into the second turn, angled in on that turn and also weakened.
