J P'S GUSTO had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away into the stretch and drew clear under urging and steady handling late. JAYCITO broke a bit slowly, came off the rail then went outside a rival on the backstretch, continued outside on the turn, swung five wide into

the stretch and was clearly second best. RIVETING REASON close up stalking the pace off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch, drifted in some and held for a share of third. INDIAN WINTER steadied in tight leaving the chute, chased between horses or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and gained a share of the show. WESTERN MOOD chased between horses then outside on the turn, came out five wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. COMMA TO THE TOP angled in and dueled outside the winner, fought back on the

turn but weakened in the stretch. JUST IMAGINE squeezed a bit at the start, went up to chase the leaders off the rail on the backstretch and into the turn, angled in leaving the turn, came out in the stretch and weakened. ROAD READY between horses early, chased outside then four

wide, continued outside on the turn and three deep into the stretch and did not rally. MCKENZIES WAY saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch, angled back in and was not a threat. MAJOR ART (GB) squeezed a bit at the start, settled just off the rail on the backstretch

and turn and did not rally. GAHNZO BOB five wide early, chased four wide, fell back off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out some in the stretch and was not a threat.
