1 1/4 MILES. (Turf) (1.443) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 DEL MAR OAKS(GRADE 1) FOR FILLIES, THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$400 each, which shall accompany the nomination, with \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$3,000 additional to start, with \$400,000 guaranteed, of which \$240,000 to first, \$80,000 to second, \$48,000 to third, \$24,000 to fourth and \$8,000 to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. First preference will be given to graded or group stakes winners. Second preference will be given to fillies which have finished second or third in graded or group stakes. Total non-claiming purse earnings will determine the order of preference for fillies of equal status. Entry fees will be refunded to all fillies which fail to draw into this race. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Nominations closed Thursday, August 10, 2006 with 15. (Rail at 7 feet).

Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (May), by Arch - Kalosca (FR) by Kaldoun (FR). Trainer Benson Macdonald. Bred by W. Bruce Lunsford(KY).

ARRAVALA angled in and chased inside then between horses on the second turn, came out into the stretch, rallied to the front four wide past the eighth pole and proved best. TAKE THE RIBBON chased outside a rival then inside, waited a bit leaving the second turn, came out in upper stretch and again in deep stretch and split rivals late. FOXYSOX (GB) stalked between horses then three deep on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished well. SOOTHSAI (IRE) pulled her way along three deep then outside a rival and steadied early on the backstretch, continued outside a foe, came out into the stretch, was in tight and steadied between foes in deep stretch. ATTIMA (GB) stalked outside a rival, bid three deep on the second turn, gained the lead into the stretch, was between foes past midstretch and weakened some late. MAY NIGHT angled in and chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the second turn, came out in the stretch and split foes late but was outfinished. SOL MI FA (IRE) stalked the pace inside, bid between rivals on the second turn and into the stretch, continued between horses in midstretch and weakened late. CHARMING N LOVABLE rank along the inside for a half mile, continued to save ground, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and found her best stride late. MEETMEINTEWOODS sped to the early lead outside a rival, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the second turn and until past midstretch and weakened. SECRET SCHEME chased three deep, fell back some into the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. Following a stewards' inquiry, TAKE THE RIBBON was disqualified and placed fourth.
