Weight 122 lbs. Non-Winners of \$90,000 at a mile or over in 2011 allowed 2 lbs., \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2011, 4 lbs., \$45,000 at a mile or over in 2011, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered in estimating allowances). SNOW FALL was well placed to the furlong grounds then weakened. DARING REALITY was no factor. SOUNDWAVE made a middle move to upper stretch then came up empty.
