Non-winners of \$100,000 at a mile or over other than restricted allowed 2 lbs.; \$35,000 at a mile or over, 4 lbs.; two races other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, November 15, 2008 with 18 Nominations. (Cloudy 45)

SPRINGSIDE kept on hold during the opening half, unleashed a bold four wide sweep after entering the far turn, circled rivals to reach contention approaching the top of the stretch, then sustaining her momentum, powered past the leaders to take charge in the furlong grounds, drew off with authority during the final eighth while being kept busy, then was pulled up shortly after crossing the finish line and vanned off. BOLEYN was forced to check when SKY DIVA was being taken to the two path during the run around the opening bend, ducked to the inside down the backstretch, remained within range while continuing to save ground after entering the far turn, then came back on to outfinish a pair of weakening rivals for the place. SKY DIVA three wide into the first turn, was eased to the two path soon afterwards, stalked the pacesetter while placed under rating tactics, was asked for a response upon reaching the second turn, got to within a head shy of the leader, but could advance no further, steadily tired after entering the lane. AIN'T LOVE GRAND cut the fractions while racing along the inside, was put to the test by SKY DIVA on the far turn, offered resistance, but had little left to turn back the top one's strong challenge in upper stretch, and gave way readily. BLUEGRASS PRINCESS failed to reach a contending position. STORMY'S SMILE fought against the bit early while the rider was attempting to rate her, remained forwardly placed for three-quarters and tired.
