1 1/4 MILES. (Turf) (1.451) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 *DIANA S. (GRADE 1) FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD*. No nomination fee. \$5,000 to pass the entry box. All starters will receive a \$2,500 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers if there are six (6) or more starters. All starters will be guaranteed no less than \$1,000. If only five (5) start the purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 6% to fourth and 4% to fifth. Three year olds, 118 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 twice on the turf in 2010-11 or a Grade 2 twice on the turf in 2011 allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade 1 in 2010-11 or a Grade 2 in 2011, 5 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, July 16, 2011 with 28 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile and One Eighth on the main track.). (Clear 85)

Chestnut Filly, (Mar), by Green Tune - Zaneton (FR) by Mto (GB). Trainer Brown C. Chad. Bred by E. Puerari & Oceanic Bloodstock(FR).

ZAGORA (FR) bumped lightly with ARUNA in the early going, settled in the middle of the field while off the inside, shifted four wide midway through the final turn, dropped to three wide while gaining into the stretch, was asked for run near the three-sixteenths pole, rallied to the lead passing the furlong marker, was put to a right-handed whip near the sixteenth-pole and edged clear under a strong drive. ARUNA bumped lightly with rivals early, was reserved while between horses, bided her time while two then three wide on the far turn, was asked for run while still between rivals in upper stretch, found clear running the final furlong and finished with good late energy to get the place near the wire. BAY TO BAY stalked the leader on the outside, turned up the pressure on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, drifted out some while under left hand urging around the three-sixteenths pole, was switched to a right-handed whip near the furlong marker, battled into the final sixteenth and was outfinished then caught for the place late. MEKONG MELODY (IRE) hit the outside of the gate at the start, moved in at the back of the field, lagged at the rear while saving ground, moved off the rail approaching the quarter-pole, hesitated inside that marker, was asked shortly thereafter and finished willingly but missed the show. AVIATE (GB) brushed with ARUNA in the early going, went three wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, bided her time while three then four wide on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, came under the whip while in striking range entering the final furlong but lacked the needed kick. DYNA WALTZ (GB) was well placed on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, moved out in upper stretch, was put to a drive and lacked the needed response. UNBRIDLED HUMOR came away in good order, was taken in hand while assuming the early advantage, set the pace under a snug hold while eager, was asked at the top of the stretch, vied into the final furlong and gave way. JUSTAROUNDMIDNIGHT (IRE) settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, came under the whip in upper stretch and failed to rally. GIANTS PLAY raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, dropped to one off the rail entering the stretch and tired. (Rail at 12 Feet)
