1 1/4 MILES. (Inner Turf) (1.45³) STAKES. Purse \$600,000 *DIANA S. (GRADE 1) INNER TURF FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD.* No nomination fee. \$6,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$12,000 will be accepted at any time prior to entry. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$3,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Three year olds, 118 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 twice on the turf in 2011-12 or a Grade 2 twice on the turf in 2012 allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade 1 in 2011-12 or a Grade 2 in 2012, 5 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, July 14, 2012 with 30 Nominations. (Cloudy 77)

WINTER MEMORIES came away in good order, settled into midpack taking up residence in the two path, rated kindly while stalking the pacesetter around the opening bend as well as down the backstretch, was swung into the three path entering the far turn, went on a little further and got asked for a response, this occurring in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, spun as the widest of the three front runners into the stretch, was taken in sharply to draw directly alongside TAPITSFY, had no soon done when she accelerated to the lead, opening up a quick two with a furlong remaining, drifted out steadily from the sixteenth pole, tail swishing, yet dug in with good determination to stave off the runner up. DREAM PEACE (IRE) made a quick move over to the rail right after the start, sat reserved taking the inside route under a good hold from the rider, gained the pocket once that spot was abandoned by ZAGORA around the five-sixteenths marker, closed the gap during the later stages of the run around the far turn, without need of encouragement, cut the corner into the stretch, altered course a couple of lanes to the outside a little while later and commenced to rally in earnest, gained ground on the errant winner during the final sixteenth en route for the place. ZAGORA (FR) secured the pocket in the early stages, contently tracked the pacesetter from there for just over six furlongs, availed of the opportunity and slipped outward coming to the five-sixteenths pole, just as LAW OF THE RANGE was dropping back, came two wide into the stretch under strong handling, tipped outward once the winner was sent closer to the rail, got outfinished. TAPITSFY quickly established control, was lightly coaxed along to maintain interest while setting the opening splits, came under intensified pressure heading for the quarter pole, succumbed with little resistance when WINTER MEMORIES drew abreast in upper stretch and steadily tired. HUNGRY ISLAND three wide departing the backstretch, came up empty when asked for a response prior to entering the lane. LAW OF THE RANGE (GB) accompanied the pacesetter from the outside for three-quarters while being rated along, was asked for some run early on the second bend, failed to give any and gave way.
