ROMAN DYNASTY was outrun early, rallied four wide on the second turn, dug in gamely outside in the stretch and prevailed under a drive. ON BOARD AGAIN raced in hand early, rallied three wide on the second turn, came in in the stretch and was outfinished. VALID NOTEBOOK contested the pace from the outside, was steadied along the inside in the stretch and faded. MASTER OF DISASTER contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. INDIAN HAWKE was rated along inside and tired. Following a Stewards' inquiry into the stretch run as well as the dismissal of a claim of foul by the rider of the third place finisher against the second place finisher, alleging interference in the stretch, the result was declared official.
