1 MILE. (Turf) (1.333) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 CHURCHILL DISTAFF TURF MILE S. (GRADE II) FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$10,000 at time of entry. \$1,000 to pass the entry box; \$1,000 additional to start, with \$200,000 ad ded. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three-year-olds 117 lbs.; Older 123 lb. Non-winners of a Grade I stakes at a mile or over since November 4 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade I or II stakes on the turf since October 31, 4 lbs.; \$45,000 twice on the turf in 2011, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Wednesday, April 13, 2011 with 39 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One mile.). (Cloudy 60)

Bay Filly, (Feb), by Dansili (GB) - Emplane by Irish River (FR). Trainer Mott I. William. Bred by Juddmonte Farms Ltd.(GB).

AVIATE (GB) settled off the rail, advanced between rivals mid way on the final turn, was maneuvered out seven wide, closed sharply under right handed pressure, forged to command inside the sixteenth marker then kicked clear. ARUNA rated within range while three to four wide, made progress four wide into the lane, eased out to about the six path, challenged between rivals a sixteenth out but could not match strides with the winner. FANTASIA (GB), unhurried early while off the inside, worked her way between rivals nearing the stretch, came five wide for the drive, shifted in some late and finished with decent energy inside ARUNA. ZAPPARITION was steadied when put in close soon after the break, drafted towards the back then was allowed to settle, got through along rail rallying into the lane, steadied briefly when attempting to alter outside KISS MINE near the sixteenth pole, shifted back in and finished up with interest. KISS MINE dueled four wide outside TAPITSFLY under the wire the first time, kicked well clear six furlongs out, set the pace in the two path, remained well clear into the stretch, was collared inside the furlong pole, drifted out a bit and faded. NEVER RETREAT, in mid pack while four wide, angled six wide in upper stretch and had some belated action. TAPITSFLY came out some after the break, dueled early inside KISS MINE, was rated back off that one into the turn to stalk the pace, steadily gained three wide into the lane then failed to sustain through the final furlong. WILD MIA saved ground, angled out three wide into the lane then brushed with UPPERLINE in deep stretch. UPPERLINE was steadied when in tight a few strides out of the gate, recovered and moved up towards the inside to reach a forward position, failed to respond when called upon three furlongs out, faded and brushed with WILD MIA nearing the wire.
