shifted out three wide with five-sixteenths to run, forged a clear lead leaving the final turn, but was unable to match strides with the top two late. ASKBUT I WON'TTELL settled between horses, shifted out entering the stretch to make a bold bid but lacked the needed late response. DYANI broke slow, was unhurried into stride, wheeled out six wide and improved position through the lane. HASAY (GB) was allowed to settle,

moved up five wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. GRECIAN MAIDEN settled saving ground, ranged into contention after a mile, but faltered entering the stretch and faded. ENDLESS EXPANSE (IRE) failed to respond. MISS LAA DI DA (GB) contended along the inside to the stretch and tired. MALIBU WIN was hustled along four wide for a mile and dropped out. ROYAL MADAME opened clear to set the pace, was collared leaving the final turn and stopped.
