**1½ MILES. (Turf) (2.272) STAKES. Purse \$125,000 ROOD AND RIDDLE DOWAGER S. FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD.** By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$6,250 by time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$625 to enter and an additional \$625 to start, with \$125,000 guaranteed, of which \$75,000 to the owner of the winner, \$25,000 to second, \$12,500 to third, \$6,250 to fourth, \$3,750 to fifth and \$2,500 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: Three year old fillies, 121 lbs., Older fillies and mares, 125 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or II over nine furlongs in 2011 allowed 3 lbs.; a graded stakes over nine furlongs in 2010-2011, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Rood and Riddle Dowager will be limited to twelve, with two also eligibles. In the event that the race overfills the starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners, then highest 2010-2011 earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A set of two silver julep cups will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, October 12, 2011 with 31 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at One Mile and Five-Eighths on the main track. (Cloudy 61)

SENADA settled saving ground, advanced between horses through the final turn, angled to the outside entering the stretch, quickened once uncovered, reeled in the leader and was going away. UPPERLINE tracked the pace in hand, came four wide to make her bid, forged command with a furlong to run, continued on well but was unable to resist the winner. CHEETAH (GB) was nearest the pace toward the inside, shifted out three wide with five-sixteenths to run, forged a clear lead leaving the final turn, but was unable to match strides with the top two late. ASKBUT I WON'TELL settled between horses, shifted out entering the stretch to make a bold bid but lacked the needed late response. DYANI broke slow, was unhurried into stride, wheeled out six wide and improved position through the lane. HASAY (GB) was allowed to settle, moved up five wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. GRECIAN MAIDEN settled saving ground, ranged into contention after a mile, but faltered entering the stretch and faded. ENDLESS EXPANSE (IRE) failed to respond. MISS LAADI DA (GB) contended along the inside to the stretch and tired. MALIBU WIN was hustled along four wide for a mile and dropped out. ROYAL MADAME opened clear to set the pace, was collared leaving the final turn and stopped.
