D'ARTAGNANS'SPIRIT unhurried early, was advancing into contention when steadied in behind HOW'S YOUR HALO approaching the eighth pole, recovered and rallied along the inside to be just up at the wire. ETERNAL LOOK allowed to settle, angled to the outside for the stretch run, rallied to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole but couldn't hold off the winner in the final strides. KOPPER KILGOAR chased the pace three wide into the stretch and continued on with good courage for the show while being outfinished by the top ones. WEIGELIA chased the pace, moved through inside J TOWN to take over midway of the turn, edged away in the stretch, then gave way in the final sixteenth. HOW'S YOUR HALO broke slowly, chased the pace along the rail, was caught in tight soon after entering the turn, continued to chase the pace to inside the eighth pole, then weakened. MISTER FOTIS outrun after breaking slowly, angled to the outside in the stretch and closed ground late without threatening. LITTLE THUNDER reserved racing along the inside, was advanced along the rail when blocked in behind HOW'S YOUR HALO in midstretch and failed to recover. J TOWN showed speed from the outside to nearing the stretch, then faltered. BRITISH ATTITUDE off slowly, raced in striking position three wide around the turn and faded.
