FOR THREE YEAR OLDS.* No nomination fee Supplemental nominations can be made by closing time of entries. \$1,000 to enter starters to receive a \$750 rebate. 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes at a mile or over on the turf allowed 2 lbs. Two races at a mile or over on the turf 4 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter, and restricted allowance races not considered in allowances). Closed Saturday, November 9, 2013 with 23 Original Nominations and 3 Supplements. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the Main Track.). (Cloudy 60)

Chestnut Colt, (Mar), by Smart Strike - Meridiana (GER) by Lomitas (GB). Trainer Clement Christophe. Bred by Jon Kelly & Sarah Kelly(KY).

CHAMOIS away with no apparent mishap, instantly established control, rated kindly on a loose lead during the opening stages, tipped into the two path after getting displaced by VINNY GOODTIMES nearing the end of the backstretch, ranged up to apply pressure on that rival, arrived at the quarter pole and challenged in earnest, took over in short order, remained comfortably in the clear crossing the wire put to a hand drive. NOTACATBUTALLAMA was rapidly tucked along the inside route, responded positively when given some hand urging and closed the gap early down the backstretch, got switched over to rating tactics after having achieved the goal, got asked for some run once again upon entering the far turn, slipped into the two path approaching the five-sixteenths marker, turned for home and got put to a drive, proved no match for the winner while continuing onward in a willing manner to procure the place. JOHA left the rail shortly after entering the backstretch, took the three path around the far turn, swung into the stretch and got outfinished. TATTENHAM rode the rail to the quarter pole, fanned outward traversing through the furlong grounds until about five wide by its end, mustered up a mild late response en route for the last major check. NORTH SLOPE raced from off the inside, started the run around the second bend three wide, fanned outward spinning into the stretch, eventually settling into being six to seven wide, went on to mainly improve position. VINNY GOODTIMES strung out four wide on the opening bend, worked his way past the winner to grab away the advantage coming to the end of the backstretch, was sent over to the rail once sufficiently clear to do so, got put to the test by the top one approaching the quarter pole, succumbed and backed away. MILLS three wide on the first turn, was one path wider on the subsequent one, had no rally. WIND OF BOSPHORUS off the rail, failed to come up with asked for a response at the five-sixteenths pole.
