A supplemental nomination fee of \$2,000 in addition to the entry fee may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. All starters including supplemental nominees to receive a \$ 1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$200,000 at a mile or over in 2012 allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000 or ther than restricted stake at a mile or over, or three races, 5 lbs.; two races, 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter or restricted races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. TEETH OF THE DOG well rated accompanying the pace maker from the two path, raced between foes in the turn as all three stacked up noses apart on the front end, poked a nostril in front at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home, was confronted by the runner up at the eighth pole, dueled from there to the wire, exchanged light bumps late on with that foe while digging in resolutely to prevail. FAST FALCON unhurried at the rear while just off the inside, came under urging at the three-eighths pole, swung four wide for home making steady progress on the front, engaged the aforementioned rival with a furlong to go, displayed good kick through to the wire battling in game fashion, exchanged light bumps late on drifting slightly under off sided stick work while well clear for place honors. MORGAN'S GUERRILLA hustled from the start, set the pace inside accompanied immediately from the start, had the pressure intensify as a pair of rivals engaged him heads apart from the half mild pole through the turn, got displaced at the five-sixteenths and came under encouragement in response, lost position to the eighth pole, had no response for the top two while coming again mildly to reacquire the show honors. ZETTERHOLM after settling, ranged up to engage the pair up front at the seven-sixteenths pole, contested the pace from there through the turn, spun three wide for home, and lacked the needed response. GUYANA STAR DWEEJ raced in midpack from just off the inside, came under a drive at the five-sixteenths and offered no kick. UNSTOPPABLE U three wide in close range of the front, lost position and ground through the turn and was eased at the top of the lane. MONARCHIC crossed to the inside soon after the start, sat just off the pace inside, lost action at the seven-sixteenths pole, was pulled up and vanned off.
