Davis (NY). FISH TRAPPE ROAD four to five wide in range of the front, came under light coaxing five-sixteenths from home, swung three wide into upper

stretch, rallied to take command three-sixteenths from home drifting in to the rail near the eighth pole under a brief off sided stick, inched away

under a drive, dug in and held sway to prevail at the finish. ECONOMIC MODEL just off the pace four then three wide through the turn, came under coaxing five-sixteenths out, took to the inside vacated by THE GREAT WHITEWAY backing out to cut the corner into upper stretch, took narrow LAOBAN as the aforementioned foe drifted to the inside a furlong out, ran on to chase the winner home knocking heads to the wire with TALE OF

brief command three-sixteenths out before displaced by the eventual winner, angled out to the two path nudging lightly and following out S'AVALL through the final sixteenth and just got the nod for the place honors. TALE OF S'AVALL chased three to four wide from mid pack, came under coaxing midway on the turn, continued three to four wide into upper stretch, rallied with a mild kick under a heavy drive to knock heads through the final sixteenth with the aforementioned rival but lost the bob at the finish while clear for the show. VOLUNTARIO detached at the rear

unhurried early on, chased three wide coming under encouragement three furlongs from home, angled six wide at the top of the stretch, improved position for the last major share. LAOBAN fractious in the gate prior to the start, bobbled at the break, dueled three to four wide with THE GREAT WHITEWAY to his inside through the turn, inherited the front five-sixteenths out as his main pace foe backed away steadily through the

latter portion of the bend, swung just off the inside between foes at the head of the stretch, got headed three-sixteenths out, shifted to the three path nudged gently by ECONOMIC MODEL near the eighth pole and weakened in the final furlong. UNBRIDLED OUTLAW bumped at the start by LAOBAN who recovered outwards from a bobble, chased three to four wide under encouragement from midway on the turn, angled six wide into upper stretch, offered no response. SWIPE chased just off the inside early on before tucking to the rail through the turn, came under a ride at

the three-eighths, angled three to four wide at the quarter pole and made no impact. THE GREAT WHITEWAY coaxed from the gate, dueled three then two wide with LAOBAN to his outside, gave up the front near the five-sixteenths under coaxing, steadily retreated through to the quarter pole, swung two to three wide at that station and folded.
