By subscription of \$150 each which should accompany the nomination. \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,250 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The Purse to be divided as follows, \$87,000 to the owner of the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth, \$3,000 to sixth with the remaining \$3,000 to be divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake at a mile or over, allowed 2 lbs.; of a Sweepstake at a mile or over, 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming or starter at a mile or over, 6 lbs.; such a race at a mile or over, 8 lbs. ECONOMIC MODEL settled into the two path after a clean breakaway, was patiently handled keeping watch on the front runners, got caught in behind a wall of rivals approaching the quarter pole, stepped into the stretch with no improvement with regards to his predicament, had a seam open up in the three path between rivals in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, was given its cue and boldly burst through to poke a head down in the front at the start of the final furlong, kicked clear, kept to encouragement to the end. RACE ME HOME (IRE) shied in momentarily from an errant CUPID during the initial stages, chased the pace from the two path put to a prolonged hard drive, fanned out into path five during the opening phases of the stretch run, got straightened away and rallied for place honors. RALLY CRY contended for the lead from between rivals early down the backstretch, dropped back from that dispute, responding to instructions from the pilot as the tempo picked up several ticks during the setting of the second split, stayed within striking distance taking the three path around the turn, was asked for his best prior to the quarter pole, drifted out slightly soon after enteing the stretch, got outfinished and lost the place. HIT IT ONCE MORE was hand urged leaving the gate to secure the top, cut over to the inside, vied matched up with a pair to the outside early down the backstretch, then went at one on one with CUPID afterwards, got set down right around the five-sixteenths pole, still engaged with the aforementioned foe, got overhauled a furlong later and faltered. CUPID seemed headstrong nearly from get-go, got checked and tipped out into the two path on the chute, was given some rein and rushed up to confront HIT IT ONCE MORE as the first fraction was being recorded, tucked into the two path coming to the end of the backstretch and proceeded to race as a team with the last-named foe, drifted out slightly after settling into upper stretch and gave way.
