WEST COAST bumped between foes at the start and squeezed back due to pressure from LOCAL HERO inside and OUTPLAY to the outside, chased five wide, came under coaxing three furlongs from home and bid powerfully through the latter portion of the turn to circle four wide to the issue a challenge swinging three wide into upper stretch, took over command straightened away, edged clear under a drive to prevail. YOU'RE TO BLAME bumped at the start by OUTPLAY and in turn bumped and squeezed back the aforementioned foe due to that pressure, chased five wide down the backstretch until tucked three to four wide nine-sixteenths out, came under coaxing just past the three-eighths, angled six wide into upper stretch, offered up a good finish to close in and secure the place honors. OUTPLAY broke in at the start bumping YOU'RE TO BLAME into WEST COAST and squeezing that rival back along with TALE OF SILENCE in tandem with pressure from LOCAL HERO breaking outwards to the inside, chased four then three wide from just off the pace, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, spun just off the inside into upper stretch briefly heads apart for command, then weakened in the late stages while well clear for the show honors. JAMMINWITHBRANDON broke out at the start and bumped LOCAL HERO into TALE OF SILENCE, chased five then four wide through the turn coiming under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung four wide into upper stretch and tired. TALE OF SILENCE got bumped between foes and pinched back at the start, chased three then two wide, came under coaxing midway on the turn, swung three wide at the guarter pole and passed tired rivals in the stretch. WICKED MACHO established the front and showed the way in hand along the inside through swift splits under pressure from OUTPLAY to the outside, came under coaxing five-sixteenths out, cut the corner into upper stretch displaced from command and faltered in the drive. LOCAL HERO bumped at the start by JAMMINWITHBRANDON and in turn bumped TALE OF SILENCE into WEST COAST squeezing those rivals back in concert with pressure from the outside provided by OUTPLAY, chased forwardly placed three then two wide under urging from three furlongs out, spun just off the inside for home and folded.
